Lunch and dinner:

At own contribution there will be the possibility for lunch before and after the workshop at different canteens near to the institute. There will be an opportunity for a joint dinner on the 7th in the old centre of Bergedorf. Please inform Mrs Khalil, if you like to join to lunch and/or to the social dinner also by using the registration form.

Route description:

From Hamburg Airport „Fuhlsbüttel“ use the Metroline „S1“ to reach Hamburg main station. At Hamburg main station change to metroline „S21“ direction „Aumühle, Reinbek, Bergedorf“ and descent at metrostop Bergedorf.

From the metrostation a taxi takes 5 min to "Leuschnerstrasse 91" (there are currently extensive reconstruction measures at Bergedorf Metrostation. The taxi rank is at the backside of the station close to the bus stops).

or

From the metrostation it is a 5 minute bus ride to the centre/hotel by bus line 234 direction "Lohbrügger Weg" (all busses of line 234, start at Bergedorf train station, thus there is only one direction!). Descent at "Plettenbergstrasse" for the institute or "Lohbrügger Weg" for the hotel.
